Amanda Giordano, PhD, LPC, NCC is an assistant professor at the University of North Texas. She specializes in multiculturalism, religious/spiritual issues in counseling, and addictions counseling. Giordano frequently presents and publishes on topics related to diversity considerations, effects of systemic privilege and oppression, and advocacy. Giordano serves on the executive board of the Association for Spiritual, Ethical, and Religious Values in Counseling, the board of directors for First Refuge Ministries, and a racial reconciliation panel called RESET.



Peggy Ceballos, PhD is an Associate professor at the University of North Texas. Her research focuses on social justice and multiculturalism in the field of counseling, particularly for Spanish speaking clients. Currently, she coordinates counseling services for children in two pre-school programs in the Denton area and collaborates with other researchers to address multicultural supervision of play therapists providing bilingual services. She has conducted over 40 professional presentations related to multicultural counseling and social justice; including, professional trainings on culturally responsive interventions.
